Introduction

"Our industry is precious to us. Together we can protect it and make it grow."

Through this publication, the American Floral Endowment undertakes the pleasant obligation of sharing its accomplishments with those who make them possible. At the same time, we continue to seek ways to extend the capabilities more broadly in order to serve the floral industry and the public in general.

During 1988 we expanded our donor base and received pledges totaling over \$1.5 million when over forty men and women gathered in Chicago for the Endowment's fourth phone-a-thon.

Following up on the number one priority identified at the 1987 Endowment sponsored National Research Priorities Summit, initiatives are underway for Phase I of an all industry statistical information gathering project. Designated the "Together to Gather" program, five major wire services have agreed to input data retroactive to January 1988, to be continued on a monthly basis during 1989. Information on this program will be published as we progress.

The rapid advance in technological innovation provides fertile ground for researchers in the physical sciences. Through support from the Endowment we have been successful in encouraging a focus on floriculture and environmental horticulture work.



The past year showed financial improvement but also the impact of a turbulent financial market. The principal account reached new highs but earnings percentages were down slightly as a result of the financial market conditions.


The Phone-a-thon held in the summer of 1988 generated substantial support. The Endowment is looking forward to growth in the principal account exceeding 5.8 million dollars by 1993.

In 1988 the Endowment continued its policy of using all income from the principal account to fund research. The administrative expenses for the Endowment are paid with funds provided by special fund raisers held throughout the year. All of the trustees pay their own expenses; they receive no reimbursement of any kind.

Every contributor can be confident that their contribution will become a part of the "corpus" (principal) of the Endowment and that the income from that contribution will each year be used to fund research and education programs.





1988 Research Grants

Breeding

1. Biotechnological Breeding of Alstroemeria. University of Connecticut, Dr. Mark Bridgen Cornell University, Dr. Robert Langhans The Pennsylvania State University, Dr. Richard Craig \$48,114.15 - 3rd year

Objective: To develop, within three years, new cultivars of Alstroemeria for the American flower growers and florists.

2. Breeding, Tissue Culture and Crop Improvement of Tuberose (Polianthes tuberosa L.) University of Illinois, Dr. Martin Meyer, Jr. \$9,500

Objectives: To breed new improved cultivars of tuberose for the florist industry and develop improved propagation procedures so that commercially significant quantities of superior cultivars can be rapidly introduced by micropropagation.

Energy

3. Root Zone Heating of Bench Grown Pot Crops: Effects of Type of Heating System on Temperature Regimes and Plant Responses. Cornell University, Dr. Robert Langhans \$15,500 - 2nd year

Objective: To develop precise data on the heating characteristics of the six bottom heating systems.


New Crops

4. Control of Flowering and Postharvest Physiology of Rhipsalidopsis gaertneri (Easter cactus). University of Massachusetts, Dr. Thomas Boyle, University of Wisconsin, Dr. Dennis Stimart \$8,400

Objectives: Determine the effect of photoperiod and temperature on flower initiation and development; evaluate numerous Rhipsalidopsis cultivars for growth and flowering responses; determine the role of nitrogen fertilization on phylloclade maturation and subsequent flowering; study postharvest physiology of flowering plants; and develop a schedule for year-round flowering of Easter cactus.

5. Genetic and Cultural Investigation of New Pelargoniums from the Cape Floristic Kingdom. Cornell University, Dr. Thomas Weiler, Ernie DeMarie \$12,500 - 2nd year

Objectives: Develop tissue culture propagation procedures for choice Pelargonium species and new hybrids; determine the cultural conditions most appropriate for commercial production; and develop new hybrid Pelargonium opportunities through interspecific hybridization technology.



 Regional Evaluation in a National New Crops Program.
 USDA, ARS, Dr. Roger Lawson
 \$25,000 - 2nd year

Objectives: To establish a regional evaluation program of new crops and develop cultural production protocols. (This is an extension of the industry-USDA new crops program sponsored jointly by USDA, SAF and the Endowment.)

Pest Management

7. Control of Botrytis Cinerea on Rose. University of California, Davis, Dr. James J. Marois \$9,000 - 2nd year

Objectives: To develop an integrated pre- and postharvest control program for Botrytis Cinerea in greenhouse production systems; to further develop the biological control agents identified in previous work funded by the Endowment; to investigate the potential for manipulation of the greenhouse environment to reduce disease; and to provide chemical and cultural control methods for postharvest control of the disease.

8. Control Program for the Sweetpotato Whitefly on Commercial Flower Crops. University of Florida, IFAS, Dr. James F. Price \$20,000

Objectives: Evaluate ca. 50 pesticides for effects on each growth stage of the sweetpotato whitefly; study timing of applications to whitefly populations for the most promising candidates identified; determine proper concentrations for most promising candidates; for likely candidate insecticides, provide data to manufacturers to support new flower registrations; and develop and communicate stepwise programs for control of sweetpotato whitefly on ornamental crops.

9. Development of Integrated Pest Management Strategies in Floriculture. University of California, Riverside, Dr. Michael Parrella \$40,680

Objectives: To develop a comprehensive literature review of major floriculture pests in addition to surveying the thrips species complex in floriculture in the United States in conjunction with the National Agricultural Library; continue biological studies of major pests including leafminers, western flower thrips, aphids and beet armyworm; evaluate old and new insecticides, tank mixes,

microbial pesticides, and insecticide resistance with respect to the above pests; and develop and refine biological control studies for many of the major floricultural crop pests.

10. Fungicide Sensitivity of Botrytis Cinerea Infecting Greenhouse Crops. The Pennsylvania State University, Dr. Gary W. Moorman \$10,000

Objectives: Isolate Botrytis from greenhouse floricultural crops; establish for each population a dosage response curve to selected fungicides; compare the pathogenic and saprophytic fitness of fungicideresistant and fungicide-sensitive populations; determine the stability fungicide-resistant populations when in direct competition with a fungicidesensitive population on plant tissue; and test the efficacy of methods of preventing, delaying or reversing the development of fungicide-resistant populations on plant tissue.

11. Improved Methods for Serological Detection and Differentiation of Tomato Spotted Wilt Virus Strains. USDA, ARS, Dr. Roger Lawson \$6,000

Objective: Improve methods of detection of the virus utilizing serological test procedures and monoclonal antibodies with broad-spectrum reactivity.

12. Plant Resistance for Management of Greenhouse Whitefly on Poinsettia.
Cornell University, Dr. John P. Sanderson \$21,500

Objectives: Determine the degree of resistance/ susceptibility to the greenhouse whitefly (GHWF) of a wide variety of poinsettia cultivars in order to identify resistant germplasm; determine the impact of plant resistance on host plant acceptance, reproduction, and population biology of GHWF; investigate mechanisms of poinsettia resistance to GHWF; and compare the efficacy of insecticides against GHWF on resistant and susceptible varieties.

13. Controlling Pythium with Beneficial Soil Bacteria. Washington State University, Dr. Virginia I. Lohr \$5,000

Objective: Determine the range of crops on which strain V14 can control damping-off and other root and stem rots caused by Pythium. (The researchers have isolated a strain of beneficial soil bacteria, strain V14, that reduces damping-off caused by Pythium in Dianthus chinensis.)

14. Development of Whitefly and Spider Mite Resistance through Somaclonal Variation. University of Connecticut, Dr. Mark Bridgen, and Cornell University, Dr. John P. Sanderson \$16,000

Objective: Determine if whitefly and spider mite resistance can be developed on greenhouse plants through the biotechnological process of somaclonal variation.

15. Biology and Control of Whiteflies. University of California, Riverside, Dr. Michael Parrella \$25,500

Objectives: To compare life history characteristics of greenhouse whitefly (GHWF) and sweetpotato whitefly (SPWF) on selected hosts; to evaluate new and old insecticides against both species; and to assay for potential insecticide resistance in GHWF and SPWF.

16. Evaluate the Problem of Monomorium Pharaonis Infested Ornamental Plants in Interior Landscapes and Develop Control Measures. University of Florida, CFREC, Dr. Lance Osborne \$7,000

Objectives: Establish colonies in the laboratory and greenhouse to be used as test colonies; evaluate the efficacy of various insecticide formulations against laboratory colonies of pharaoh ants; and study biology of pharaoh ants under interior and greenhouse conditions. (Study completed.)

Physiology

17. Effect of Air Velocity and Humidity on Cavitation in Greenhouse Crops. Colorado State University, Dr. Joe J. Hanan \$15,000

Objectives: Correlate acoustic emissions with imposed environment; determine means to incorporate acoustic emission monitoring in computerized climate control of greenhouses; evaluate response of cut flower roses to variations in humidity and air velocity; and derive recommendations for humidity and air velocity levels for maximizing yield and quality.

18. Temperature Mediated Hormone Deficiency Associated with Chrysanthemum Slow Decline. USDA, ARS, Dr. Roger Lawson \$7,000 - 3rd year

Objective: To determine if decline is induced as a result of a hormone imbalance and if this imbalance is influenced by the growing temperature.

Post Production Studies

19. Physiological and Hormonal Factors Related to Longevity of Flowering Potted Plants. University of Florida, Dr. Terril Nell \$10,300 - (extension of previous study)

Objectives: To identify physiological parameters related to increased longevity of flowering potted plants; and evaluate the effects of exogenous growth substances on extending the longevity of flowering potted plants.

20. Preharvest and Postharvest Factors Influencing the Quality of Shipped Pelargonium Cuttings. The Pennsylvania State University, Dr. Richard Arteca \$12,042 - 2nd year

Objectives: Identify the physiological differences between good vs. poor shippers and rooted vs. non-rooted Pelargonium cuttings, and ultimately determine optimal pre and postharvest treatments which increase cutting survival rate and rooting ability following simulated shipping conditions.



21. Leaf and Flower Abscission during Shipment of Miniature Roses.

Clemson University, Dr. John Kelly and Texas A & M University, Dr. H. Brent Pemberton \$8,500 - 2nd year

Objectives: To determine critical environmental parameters causing miniature rose leaf abscission in response to a shipping environment; determine how environmental factors such as temperature and/or photoperiod can be manipulated during production to optimize shipping success; and develop economically viable production, shipping and marketing methods to allow for reliable profitability from the sales of miniature rose plants.

22. Photosynthesis, Carbohydrate Availability, and Floret Longevity in Regal Pelargonium. The Pennsylvania State University, Dr. Kathleen Evensen \$6,000 - 2nd year

Objectives: Determine photosynthetic rates, light compensation points and dark respiration rates in related lines of Pelargonium x domesticum with different postharvest characteristics; and relate photosynthetic and respiration rates to the carbohydrate content and partitioning in the plants.



23. Apical Carbohydrate Level and Flowering in Zantedeschia. University of Minnesota, Dr. Richard Widmer \$8,900 - 2nd year

Objectives: To determine the relationship of apical carbohydrate levels and flower initiation in Zantedeschia rehmannii; and continue to increase the practicality and profitability of production of Zantedeschia as a floricultural crop by determining cultural requirements.

Production Technology

24. Optimization of the Greenhouse Environment for Rosa hybrida L. Production Using Computer Growth Modeling.

Purdue University, Dr. P. Allen Hammer \$4,500 - 2nd year

Objective: To develop a simulation model relating growth to environmental parameters for five types of flower development.

25. Horticultural Evaluation of Fluctuating Night Temperatures. Michigan State University, Dr. Royal D. Heins \$5,000

Objectives: Verify if the fluctuating night temperatures (FNT) responses observed in Israel are reproducible in the northern United States, and if reproducible, determine how widespread the beneficial response to FNT is among important floriculture plant species.

26. Developing New Techniques for Control of Stem Elongation in Plants with Temperature and Light. Michigan State University, Dr. Royal D. Heins \$14,300 - 2nd year

Objective: Determine new methods which may be used to control stem elongation of plants.

Special Projects

The Endowment policy continues to be to emphasize the development of the Endowment. However, in 1982, the Board determined that designated funds may be received to support projects approved by the Board for such funding.

Two long term designated funding programs were established with cooperative agreements

signed between the Endowment and the U.S. Department of Agriculture in 1984: New Crops Development and A Centralized Research Information Data Base.

The new crops program is sponsored jointly by the Society of American Florists (SAF), USDA and the Endowment, and supported financially in varying amounts by over twenty industry firms and organizations. Being conducted at the USDA Florist and Nursery Crops Laboratory, Beltsville, Maryland, the program will begin its fifth year in 1989. SAF serves as industry liaison.

Dubbed *The Floriculture Information Connection*, work continues on developing this centralized research information data base at the National Agricultural Library, also in Beltsville, Maryland. Publication of an annotated bibliography on marketing of floricultural products is expected early in 1989. The Endowment continues to serve as liaison for the industry with NAL.

Progress Reports



Dr. Marlin Rogers

Semi-annual progress reports are required on all Endowment funded research projects, with final reports to be submitted upon completion of the work. The purpose is to enable Trustees to stay abreast of the status of projects funded by the Endowment and to assure that objectives remain constant. While it is not always feasible to publish progress reports, any individual desiring information may have a copy of available material upon request to the Endowment office. When practical, reports are issued to the industry and general public through trade publications.

While the Endowment Board of Trustees makes final decisions, the SAF Research Committee has reviewed proposals and made recommendations to the Board for funding since 1978. To assist in this endeavor, the Endowment provides expenses for an advisor from the academic community. Dr. Marlin Rogers, University of Missouri, is the current advisor.
