# Floriculture/Horticulture Opportunities for Students AND Advisors!

## PAID INTERNSHIPS AVAILABLE Application Deadline: March 1st!



Internships play a vital role in helping students apply knowledge gained in the classroom to the real world, and vice versa. As such, these AFE programs are designed to sponsor student interns who will return to campus for at least a semester after completing the paid internship, but before graduating. Work with your advisor to plan for a paid internship during your college experience!

Two exciting PAID internship programs are available for students in floriculture/horticulture and include an opportunity for faculty to receive a paid trip\* to visit their students during their internship!

- **Vic & Margaret Ball Intern Scholarship Program\*** – a 3, 4, or 6 month paid internship at a major commercial production facility, plus a scholarship upon completion (\$1,500 – \$6,000). \*Faculty can receive up to \$1,000 reimbursement to visit their student on their internship!
- **Mosmiller Intern Scholarship Program** – a 10–16-week paid internship at a retail flower shop, wholesaler or allied trade organization, plus a \$2,000 scholarship upon completion.



Enclosed are **NEW** materials for the internship programs (poster and brochures), along with brochures on careers in floriculture and scholarships available! Please hang the poster where students will see it (classroom or department bulletin board) and share the brochures with your students. **Students who perform internships gain:**

- **Hands-on training** – putting their classroom knowledge to real life experiences
- **Industry Involvement** – time with industry leaders who share their knowledge
- **Experience** – putting them a step ahead of other graduates, and possible job opportunities
