ARIZONA RETAIL FLORIST EDUCATION TRAVEL GRANT

Apply for Travel Funding!

The Arizona Retail Floral Education Travel Grant was created through the American Floral Endowment to provide support for traditional retail florists in Arizona to pursue floral industry educational or design events outside of the state of Arizona.

The fund was established from the defunct FTD District 8K with additional initial funding requirements to establish the fund being provided by Ken and Lynn Young of Phoenix Flower Shops.

Each year, **one recipient will be selected by AFE's Education Committee to receive a travel grant reimbursement of up to \$1,000** to help cover the expense of attending an out-of-state industry educational event. The grant is open to owners, managers, and employees of traditional retail florists with a brick-and-mortar storefront in Arizona.

The application deadline for this grant is **October 1st** each year.

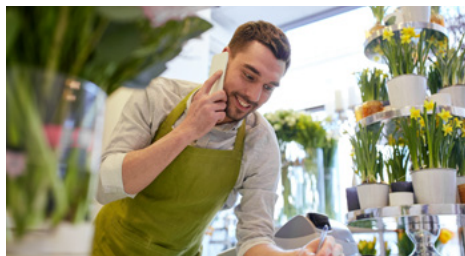
